



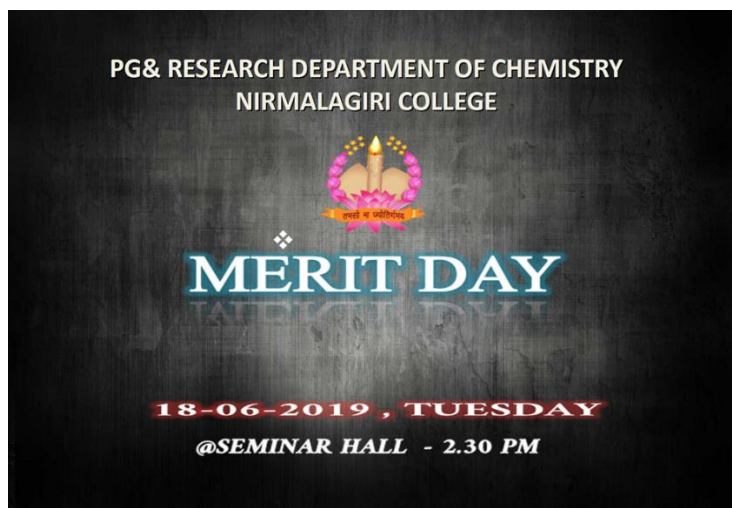

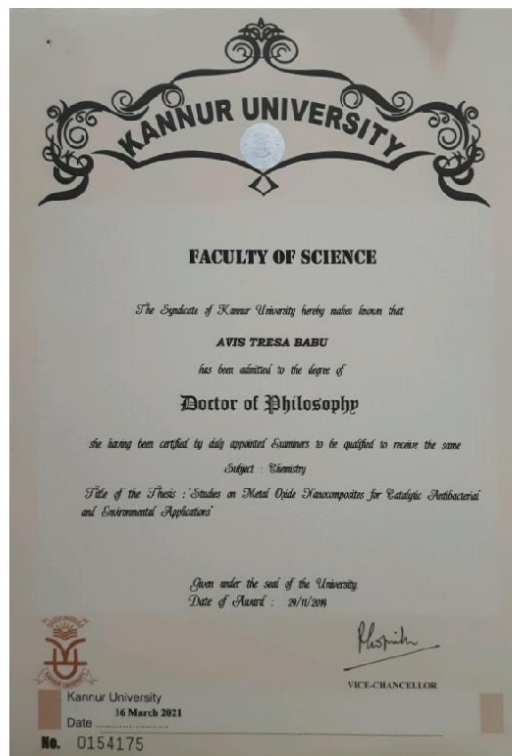
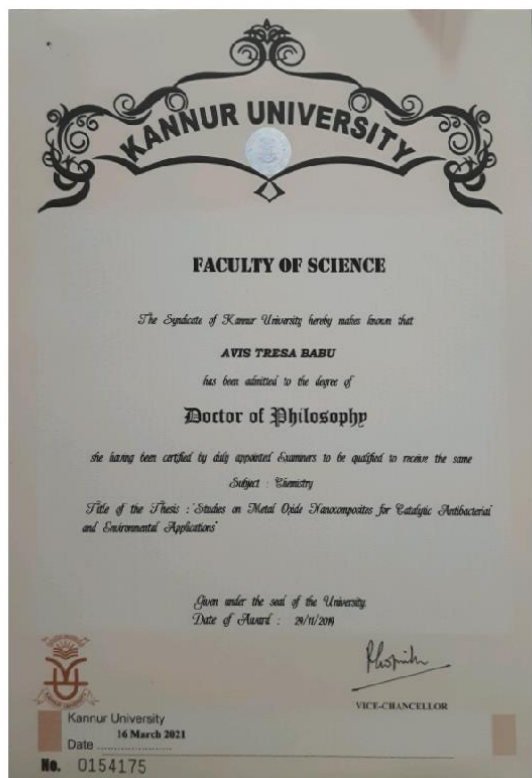

Celebrating the chemistry department with the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) in Trivandrum and raising awareness about space organizations and research is a great initiative.



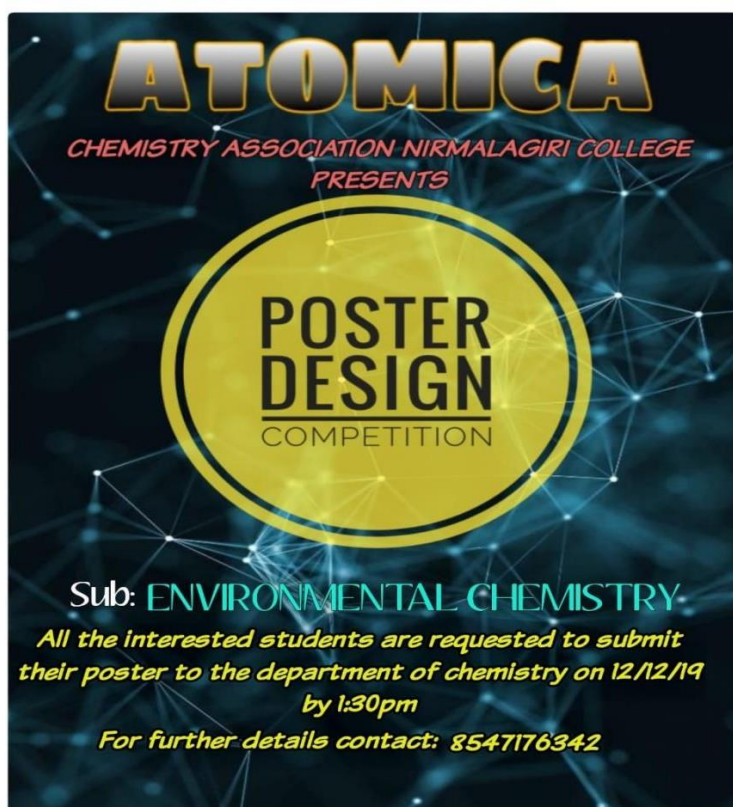


❖ Poster design competition - environmental chemistry on 12-12 2019

❖ Atomica on 18-12-2019

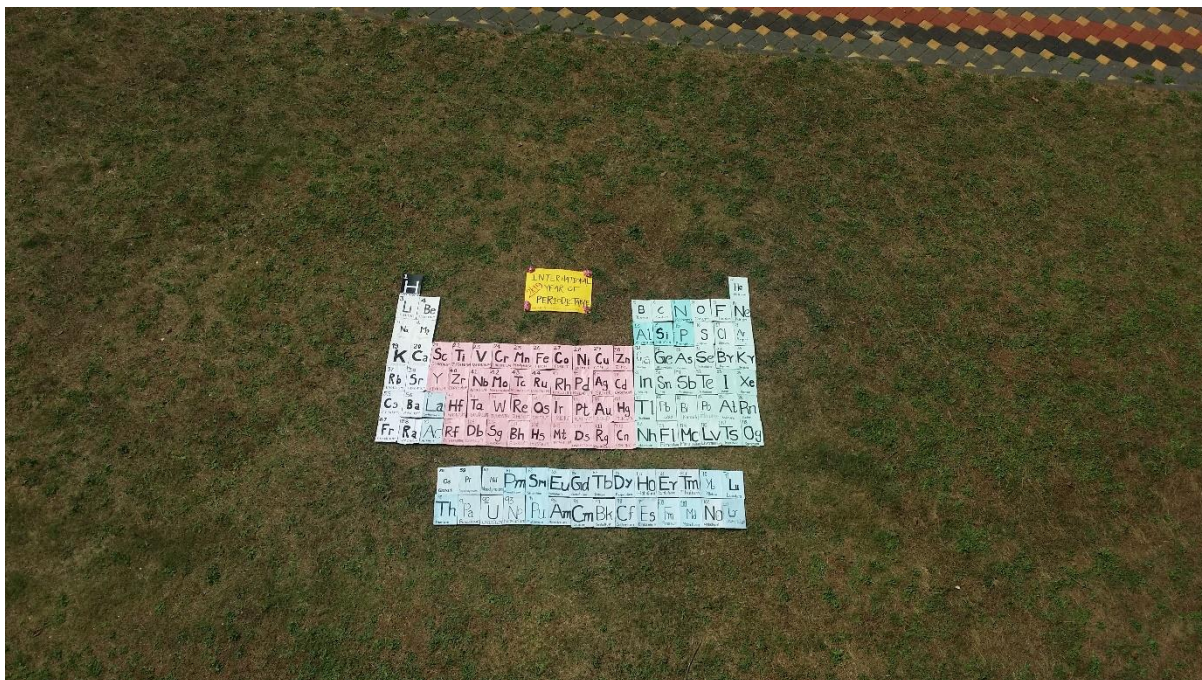
The inauguration of the Chemistry Association named "Atomica" sounds like an exciting event.
