

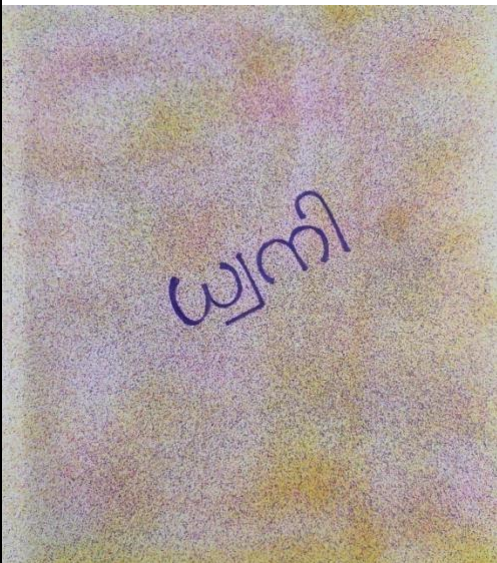
## INI MAGAZINE CONTEST

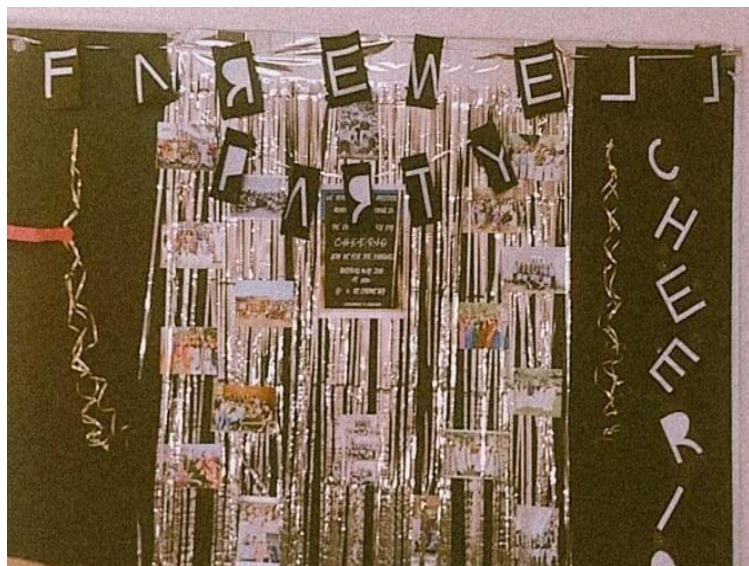


## **FAREWELL PARTY**
