The Career Guidance and Placement Cell of the College is actively involved in providing the students information on career opportunities and higher education. The cell plans and executes several training programmes aimed at equipping the students with necessary skill sets that makes them future ready and employable. 1. Self-Learning for Career Entry-Nirmalagiri College on Coursera Programme:

In order to equip the students for meeting the demands of the job market and to make them future ready, the College has partnered with Coursera, one of the leading online learning platforms in the world. The programme provided access to around 3800 high-quality courses, from world's leading universities absolutely free. During the period from 11 May 2020 to 31 December 2020, **747** students on roll and **225** alumni members utilized this facility and have accessed a total of **13195 hours of online content through 3473 course enrolments**. The programme was a great success in terms of the student participation and the experience helped them to adapt quickly to the online learning system that emerged during the pandemic period and additional skills and competencies essential for a career start.

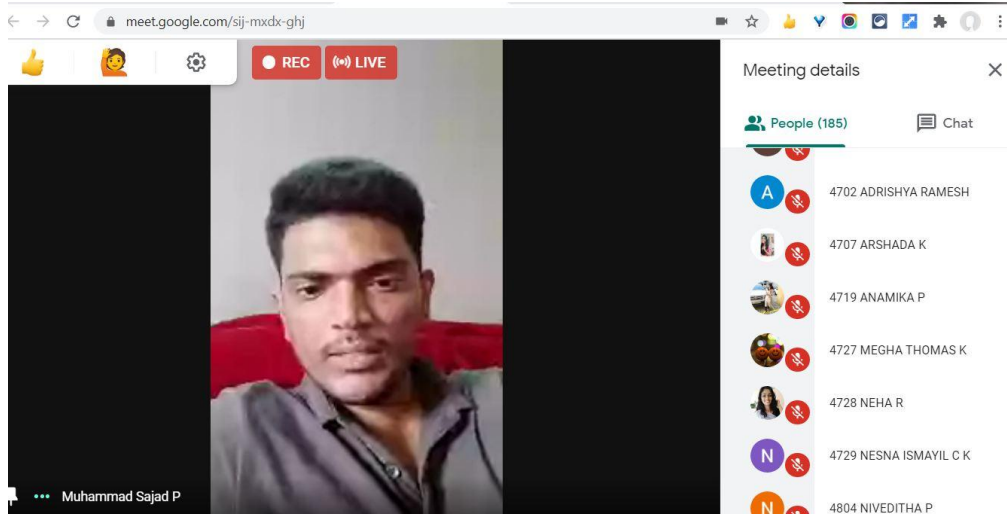

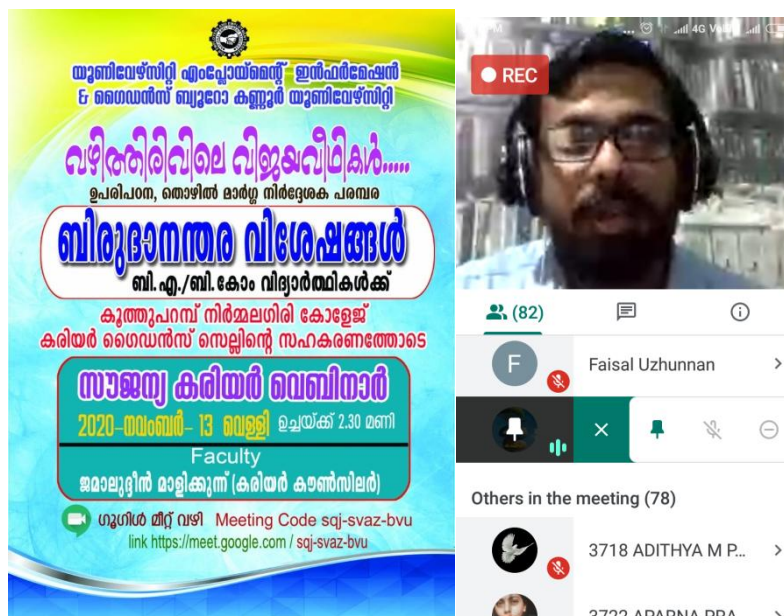

Our students participated in the campus placement programmes organized by The South Indian Bank Ltd., Wipro, MRF etc. and 17 students have got selected as detailed below.

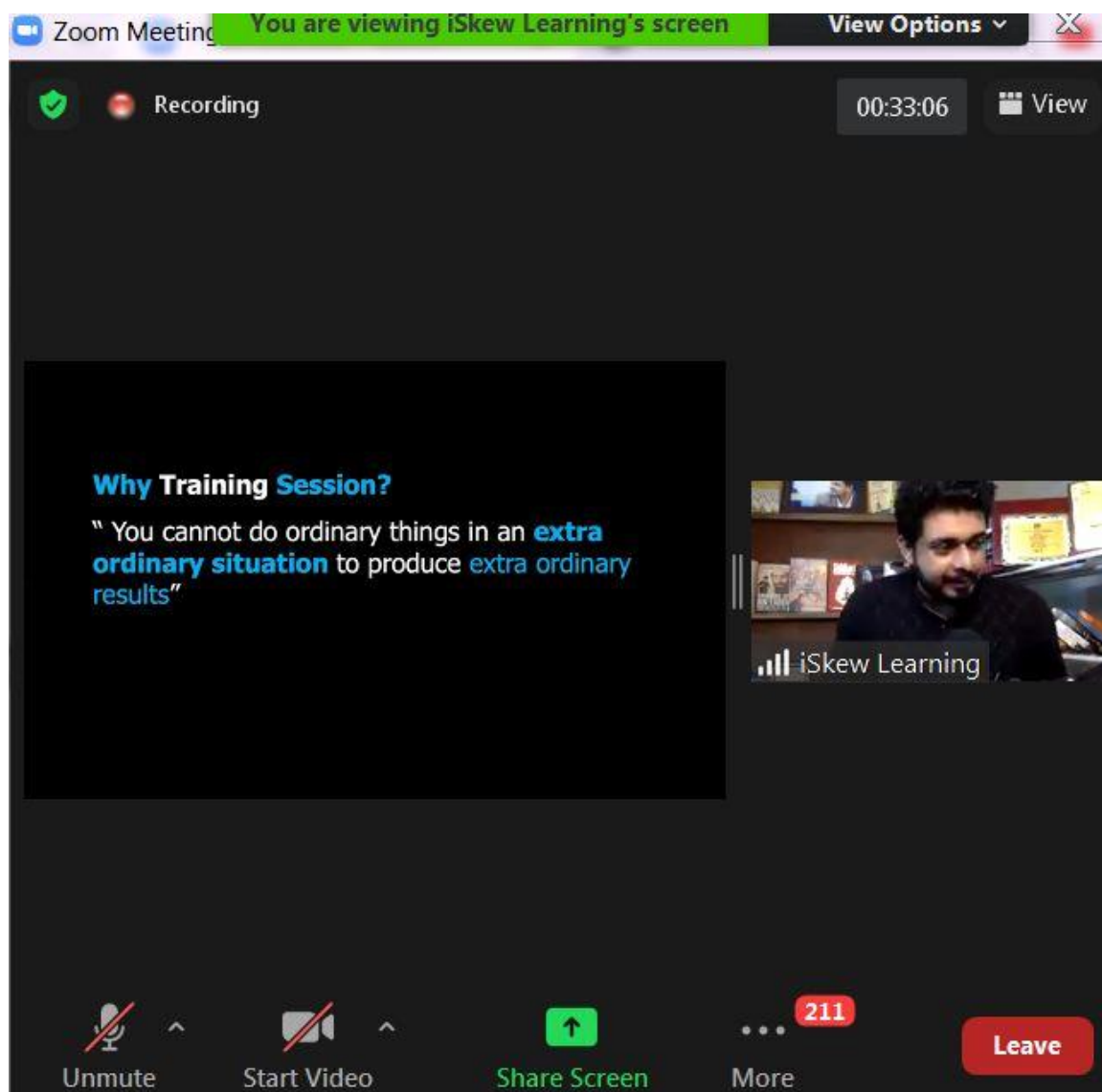

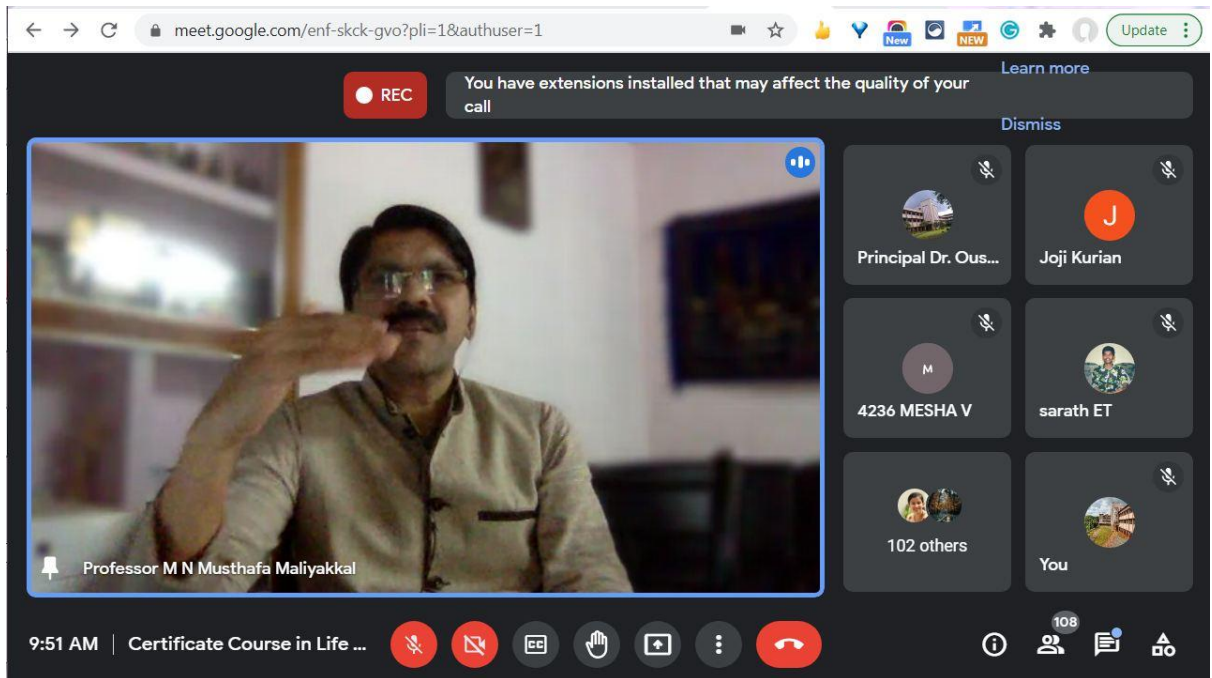
